Informative: A negative reply does not imply that the property or any adjoining or adjacent land is free from contamination or from the risk of it, and the reply may not disclose steps taken by another council in whose area adjacent or adjoining land is situated.

3.14 Radon gas

Do records indicate that the property is in a Radon Affected Area as identified by Public Health England?

Ceredigion is an area where radon precautions may be required for new dwellings. Radon Affected Areas are designated by the National Radiological

Protection Board. It is recommended that the level of radon gas should be measured in all properties within Radon Affected Areas. The present owner or (for a new property) the builder should be asked whether protective measures were incorporated in the construction of the property; whether radon levels were at or above the Action Level (prescribed by the NRPB) and if so whether radon levels were re-tested and confirmed the effectiveness of the measures.
